Day 1 - Monday, November 28 - Cleveland, TN – Motor coach from Zachary, Baton Rouge through Denham Springs, Hammond, and Birmingham with overnight in Cleveland, TN.

EXPERIENCE THE BILTMORE ESTATE - The world-famous Biltmore House and Gardens was built by George Vanderbilt, youngest grandson of business tycoon Commodore Cornelius Vanderbilt, in 1895. He envisioned an estate that would not only showcase his collection of art, but also be a self-supporting business. With just 4 acres of floor space it contains 250 rooms, 65 fireplaces, 43 bathrooms and 3 kitchens. Vanderbilt included such technology as an elevator, and a swimming pool with underwater lighting, and over 100 decorated Christmas trees for the holiday season.

Day 2 - Tuesday, November 29 - Asheville, NC – Morning drive through the beautiful **Smokies**. Check into our hotel located on the grounds of **Biltmore**. Lighted tour of the spectacular **Biltmore Estates**, with its 250-room mansion and 75 acres of formal gardens - America's most imposing house. Enjoy an included Holiday Dinner. (B, D)

Day 3 - Wednesday, November 30 - The Greenbrier - Travel through beautiful eastern Tennessee and the scenic **Shenandoah Valley** of Virginia for mid-afternoon arrival at the **Greenbrier Hotel** in White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia for a two-night stay in the heart of the **Allegheny Mountains**.
