Day 1 - Sunday, July 17 - Calgary, Canada – Today we fly into Canada, home of the spectacular Canadian Rockies. Overnight in Calgary.

Day 2 - Monday, July 18 - Banff – This morning we head north through the beautiful Kananaskis Valley for Banff, a vibrant mountain town. Enjoy a sightseeing tour of the area with stops at the lovely **Bow Falls** and at the fascinating **Hoodoos**. Return to Banff. Enjoy a leisurely afternoon in downtown **Banff**. Overnight in Banff.

Day 3 - Tuesday, July 19 - Banff – Today we enjoy a **gondola ride** for panoramic views of the majestic Canadian Rockies. Enjoy free time this afternoon to explore more of the beauty of Banff on your own.

Day 4 - Wednesday, July 20 - Lake Louise - A wonderful day of sightseeing as we stop and enjoy two beautiful Canadian lakes. Visit **Moraine Lake** in the **Valley of the Ten Peaks**. Then, enjoy a leisurely visit at **Lake Louise**, famous for its turquoise-colored water from **Victoria Glacier** and ringed by high peaks and overlooked by a stately chateau. Overnight in the Banff area.

Day 5 - Thursday, July 21 - Jasper - Today, we journey along the unforgettable **Icefield Parkway** and see lofty waterfalls, rushing rivers and glacial peaks. Enter the vast, unspoiled grandeur of 4,200 square mile **Jasper Park**, Canada's largest national park where we enjoy a relaxing two-night stay. Dinner is at your lodge on the banks of the Athabasca River.

Day 6 - Friday, July 22 - Jasper – Enjoy a scenic morning drive to glacier-fed **Maligne Lake**, 14 miles long and ringed by dramatic snow-capped peaks. Look for mountain goats, moose, elk, bear, bighorn sheep, caribou and bald eagles. Next, visit **Maligne Canyon**. Then, free time to explore Jasper, a charming small town with many shops. Afternoon at leisure to enjoy the natural beauty of Jasper Park.

Day 7 - Saturday, July 23 - Calgary - Another glorious day on the **Icefields Parkway**, this time traveling south. Ride across the surface of Columbia Icefield's **Athabasca Glacier** on an all-terrain Ice Explorer (weather permitting). Walk on the Athabasca Glacier. Then descend to the **Great Plains of Canada**. Return to Calgary where we enjoy a farewell dinner.

Day 8 - Sunday, July 24 - Home – Fly home today with wonderful memories of our time in the Canadian Rockies.
