Day 1, Wednesday, Sept. 9 – Bowling Green, KY – We motor coach from Zachary to Baton Rouge, Hammond, Birmingham, AL with pickups along the way. Overnight in Bowling Green.

Day 2, Thursday, Sept. 10 – Ashtabula, OH – Through Kentucky by way of Louisville, where we will tour Churchill Downs (site of the Kentucky Derby), then through Cincinnati and Ohio. Overnight Ashtabula, OH.

Day 3, Friday, Sept. 11 – Toronto, Canada – Motorcoach to Buffalo, NY. We spend midday at Niagara Falls, visiting both sides of the falls (U.S. and Canada) with Maid of the Mist boat trip under the falls. Then through beautiful and historic Niagara on the Falls, Canada to Toronto, Canada’s largest and most cosmopolitan city, for overnight.

Day 4, Saturday, Sept. 12 – Ottawa, Canada – Morning guided orientation tour of Toronto. View City Hall, banking district, Sky Dome Stadium, Yorkville and stunning CN Tower. Then follow the shores of Lake Ontario to historic Kingston, Canada’s first capital and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. On to Ottawa, Canada’s beautiful capital city, for two nights.

Day 5, Sunday, Sept. 13 – Ottawa – Morning guided tour of Ottawa with Rideau Canal (in winter the world’s largest skating rink), Rideau Falls, the Parliament and Supreme Court and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police horse stables. Lunch and shop at the Byward Market area.

Day 6, Monday, Sept. 14- Quebec, Canada - Motorcoach to Quebec City, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and home for 2 nights.

Day 7, Tuesday, Sept. 15 - Quebec – Today we experience the beauty and history of both old and new Quebec with a fascinating sightseeing tour of the city. See the stately Chateau Frontenac, the Parliament, the St. Louis Arch and Place Royale, the site of the original settlement.

Day 8, Wednesday, Sept. 16 – Montreal – Morning departure to Montreal, the second largest French-speaking city in the world. Our Montreal tour includes Notre Dame Cathedral, St. Joseph’s oratory, Jacques Cartier Square and McGill University. Stop high atop Mount Royal for a spectacular view.

Day 9, Thursday, Sept. 17 – Albany, NY – Today we bid goodbye to Canada and enter New York State on I-87. We visit the Lake Placid area (site of the Winter Olympics) and Ausable Chasm before continuing to Albany for overnight.

Day 10, Friday, Sept. 18 – Winchester, VA – Through Pennsylvania with visits at Hershey Chocolate, Amish area and Gettysburg. Overnight in Winchester.

Day 11, Saturday, Sept. 19 - Chattanooga – Journey through the beautiful Shenandoah Valley. Overnight in Chattanooga.

Day 12, Sunday, Sept. 20 - Home – Through Birmingham, Hammond, Baton Rouge to Zachary.
