## TOUR ITINERARY

**Day 1, Saturday, July 29 –**  
Fly from Baton Rouge for overnight flight to Ireland's capital, Dublin.

**Day 2, Sunday, July 30 - Dublin, Ireland** - Morning arrival in Dublin. Visit the historic **Hill of Tara**, an ancient ceremonial and burial site. Then back to Dublin and check into our hotel for 2 nights.

**Day 3, Monday, July 31 - Dublin**– Morning guided sightseeing including world famous **St. Patrick's Cathedral, Phoenix Park & Trinity College** with eight-century **Book of Kells** (bible) and magnificent old library.

**Day 4, Tuesday, Aug. 1 - Killarney** - Today we motorcoach across southern Ireland to **Blarney Castle**, where we will have the opportunity to kiss the famous **Blarney Stone** which bestows the gift of eloquence. Then on to scenic Killarney for two nights.

**Day 5, Wednesday, Aug. 2 - Killarney** - Today we embark on Ireland's most popular scenic drive - the **Ring of Kerry**. This circular tour will reveal constantly changing vistas of mountains, open

Atlantic Ocean, beaches and cliffs. We drive through the remote towns of Cahersiveen and Waterville and return through the colorful village of Sneem. At Moll's Gap stop to view the three lakes with the mountains and town in the background.

**Day 6, Thursday, Aug 3 - Ennis** – Today another beautiful drive - the **Dingle Peninsula**, one of the most majestic coastal routes in the world. Spectacular views of the Atlantic, charming coastal villages, ancient stone huts (beehive), sight of movies such as "Ryan's Daughter" and "Far and Away". Visit the thatched roof **Adare**, perhaps Ireland's most beautiful village. Overnight in the Ennis area.

**Day 7, Friday, Aug 4 - Galway** - We view the awesome **Cliffs of Moher** (weather permitting) rising nearly 700 feet high - a truly spectacular view of Ireland's Atlantic coastline. Then visit the **Rathbaun Farm** and learn about daily life on an Irish sheep farm. Have coffee and scones in the old farmhouse.

**Day 8, Saturday, Aug. 5 - Londonderry** - Visit the **Connemara** region with the sweeping views of bog land & misty mountains; see Cong where John Wayne filmed "The Silent Man" and the Knock pilgrimage site. Overnight near Londonderry, noted for ancient medieval walls.

## TOUR ITINERARY

**Day 9, Sunday, Aug. 6 – Belfast** - Walk the walls of **Derry/Londonderry** dating back to the 17th century with 7 gates and 24 restored canons. Drive through tour of **Londonderry**, see the mysterious & impressive **Giant's Causeway**, an area of hexagonal columns. Overnight in Belfast.

**Day 10, Monday, Aug 7 - Glasgow** - Ferry from Ireland to Scotland . Transfer to Glasgow hotel where we will meet our guide.

**Day 11, Tuesday, Aug 8- Inverness** – Let your mind's eye envision a painting of Scotland... that is today. We drive along the shoreline of **Loch Lomond**, the largest and most beautiful of the lakes. Visit **Glen Coe** and **Fort William**, nestled at the foot of Britain's highest mountain, Ben Nevis. Scenic drive along **Loch Ness monster** fame. Keep an eye peeled. On to Inverness, capital of the **Highlands**.

**Day 12, Wednesday, Aug. 9 - Inverness** - We drive through more beautiful scenery to visit the **Isle of Skye** off the west coast. We tour inside **Eilean Donan Castle**, a picturesque castle that frequently appears in photographs, film and television including **Highlander** and **Skyfall**, part of the James Bond movie franchise.

**Day 13, Thursday, Aug 10 - Edinburgh** – Morning visit to **Culloden Battlefield**, significant in Scottish history. Here the Scottish forces of **Bonnie Prince Charlie** were defeated by the English in 1746, the last battle fought on Scottish soil. Drive through the eastern Highlands. Visit **St. Andrews**, where the game of golf was born. Cross the **Firth of Forth Bridge**, which takes us to Scotland's capital, **Edinburgh**, our home for 2 nights.

**Day 14, Friday, Aug 11 - Edinburgh** - Our sightseeing tour of this handsome city includes Prince's Street, the palace of **Holyrood House** and **Edinburgh Castle**, built in the 11th century and commanding a strategic site on Castlerock, overlooking the city. This afternoon, enjoy some free time for shopping or more sightseeing.

**Day 15, Saturday, Aug 12 - Home** - Today we fly home, arriving the same day.
