EXPERIENCE A TASTE OF LIFE IN THE COUNTRY

Visit Pawhuska, Oklahoma, home of popular blogger and Food Network Star Ree Drummond, known to her fans as the Pioneer Woman. Stop by the Mercantile and enjoy some shopping and tasting some of the Pioneer Woman's most popular recipes. Also includes the Fred Drummond house, the Pawhuska Swinging Bridge, Ben Johnson Cowboy Museum and a tour of the Drummond Lodge, where the Pioneer Woman's Food Network show is filmed.

Day 1, Thursday, May 14 - Fort Smith, AR - Early morning departure from Zachary through Baton Rouge, Lafayette, Alexandria and Shreveport. Overnight in Fort Smith, Arkansas.

Day 2, Friday, May 15 - Pawhuska/Bartlesville - This morning we enjoy a short drive into Pawhuska, Oklahoma, known for its Native American culture, and the Osage hills and prairie. Along the way we stop and visit the Fred Drummond home in Hominy, home to one of the top ranching families in the U.S. Then we make our way into Pawhuska, where we stop by the famous Swinging Bridge, built in 1926 that has both thrilled and terrified every creek crosser since the early days of Pawhuska. Lunch on your own at one of the downtown restaurants and then we make our way to the Mercantile, owned by Food Network Star Ree Drummond/aka Pioneer Woman. Enjoy an afternoon of shopping, pastries and coffee at the bakery, and a special included dinner featuring recipes from the Pioneer Woman herself. Overnight in Bartlesville.

Day 3, Saturday, May 16 - Pawhuska/McAlester - Today we head back to Pawhuska where we visit the Ben Johnson Cowboy Museum, and get a taste of the history of the west. Next we enjoy a tour of the Drummond Lodge, located on the Drummond Ranch. The Lodge is the Drummond family's family guest house which also serves as the production location for Ree's Food Network show. After our visit to the Lodge, we start our journey home. Overnight in McAlester, Oklahoma.

Day 4, Sunday, May 17 - After breakfast we continue our journey home, with a stop at Libbey Glass in Shreveport, known for its glassware and tabletop items.
