- Enjoy exploring downtown, which is a grid of narrow streets and alleyways that radiate out from the Central Plaza, with a plethora of shops, restaurants, art galleries and museums forming a downtown core meant to be trodded.

**Day 1, Monday, Oct. 10 – Abilene, Texas** – Early morning departure from Zachary and Baton Rouge. Pick-ups along I-10 to Lafayette, I-49 to Shreveport, I-20 through Dallas to Abilene for our overnight stop.

**Day 2, Tuesday, Oct. 11 – Santa Fe, New Mexico** – Journey through Lubbock, Tx., Clovis & Ft. Sumner, N.M. and on to Santa Fe for our 5-night stay. Our hotel provides "kick-back" from 5:30 p.m.-7:00 p.m. nightly (limited free food and drink). Time to begin to explore the **Central Plaza** area.

**Day 3, Wednesday, Oct. 12 - Santa Fe** – Morning guided tour of this 400-plus-year-old capital city. Your afternoon is free for shopping and exploring.

**Day 4, Thursday, Oct. 13 - Santa Fe - Taos** – Today we visit Taos and the area, including the famous 1,000-year-old **Taos Pueblo**, a village inhabited for more than 800 years and **Taos Plaza**. You'll also see the **Kit Carson Home and Museum** and **Rio Grande Gorge and Bridge**. Return to Santa Fe and stop for a scenic view of the Rio Grande, a legendary river that cuts a distinct path through the history of the Southwest. Your evening is free for dinner on your own.

**Day 5, Friday, Oct. 14** - Tour prehistoric Indian dwellings at **Bandelier National Monument**, and more.

**Day 6, Saturday, Oct. 15 – Santa Fe** – A free day for independent activities. Several great museums are available.

**Day 7, Sunday, Oct. 16 - Wichita Falls, Texas** – Today we motor coach toward home by way of Amarillo.

**Day 8, Monday, Oct. 17 – Santa Fe** – Home by way of Dallas and Shreveport.
