

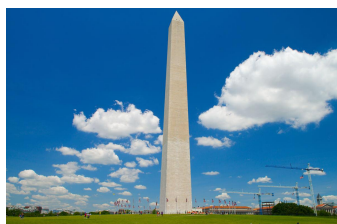

Most of the cherry trees circling the Tidal Basin in Washington, D.C. should be in peak bloom at the end of March - early April - the time we will be there – according to the National Park Service. Come with us and see them bursting with pink and white blossoms. Most are descendants of those presented to our nation by Japan in 1912 to mark 60 years of friendly relations. The blossoms are greeted by the Japanese each year as a symbol of spring, as well as the fleeting nature of life. *Note: Blossoms can vary according to the weather.*

Day 1 - Tuesday, April 5 - Cleveland, TN – Early morning departures from Zachary, Baton Rouge. Journey through Hattiesburg, Laurel and Meridian, MS. Overnight in the Cleveland area.

Day 2 - Wednesday, April 6 - Washington, D.C area - Drive across Tennessee and Virginia to Washington, our home for the next four nights. Enjoy a twilight tour of the **Iwo Jima Memorial**, the **Lincoln Memorial** and the **Korean and Vietnam Memorials**.

For the next 3 days, we will enjoy seeing many of the city and the nation’s important landmarks and historical sites. In no particular order, sightseeing will include: **National Cathedral**, **Jefferson Memorial**, the **Roosevelt Memorial** and the **World War II Memorial**, an inside visit to the **Capitol Building**, a visit to **Arlington Cemetery**, a visit to **Mt. Vernon**, a drive past **Georgetown** and the **White House** from the comfort of our motor coach, and a visit to the **Smithsonian Museums** where you can view the museums of your choice which could include the **National Archives** or the **Holocaust Museum**.

Day 3 - Thursday, April 7 - Washington, D.C. area - Sightseeing and touring of our historic capital.

Day 4 - Friday, April 8 - Washington, D.C. area - More sightseeing and touring of our historic capital.

Day 5 - Saturday, April 9 - Washington, D.C. area - A third day of sightseeing and touring of our historic capital.

Day 6 - Sunday, April 10 - Jamestown/Williamsburg – Morning sightseeing of historic **Jamestown**. This afternoon, we will visit **Williamsburg**, the former capital of Virginia. This historic area has stately public buildings and colonial homes, shops, taverns and gardens. Overnight in the Charlottesville area.

Day 7 - Monday, April 11 - Knoxville area – Visit Thomas Jefferson’s **Monticello**. Lunch included at **Michie Tavern**. Then through Virginia’s beautiful **Shenandoah Valley** and on to Tennessee for overnight.

Day 8 - Tuesday, April 12 - Birmingham - As we make our way home today, we stop in **Birmingham** for a delicious food tour, sampling dishes from some of the best restaurants in the city and learning a little more of the history and culture of the city. Overnight in Birmingham.

Day 9 - Wednesday, April 13 - Home - Drive home, arriving in Zachary this evening.
